

HAFENCITY HAMBURG

Expansion of the city centre in the dock area on the Elbe river. The project gives structure to the new part of the city centre through the design of the open public spaces and docklands. Several large "rambla" visually and functionally connect the old city with the Elbe river. These new axis are at the same time streets, boulevards, gardens, and squares with underground parking, forming a new urban space which functions as a landmark for the whole district. The project area measures 110 hectares, 5200 housing units, cultural and sport centres, a new public naval station for cruise boats and a new subway station.
