

FORLANINI PARK, MILAN

The city/nature park represents the complexity of the non-built, of variety, and of heterogeneity. It is a place where natural and human-built elements come together harmoniously, a place where the signs of human intervention and nature overlap. The city/nature park is a place that is defined but not delimited. A densification of pathways and of isolated settlements, it extends into the city along the large boulevards and continues seamlessly into the outlying countryside through a network of passages and waterways. The city expands into nature; nature spreads into the city. The park is nature in the countryside, nature in the city, city in nature: city/nature. The park is a place to pause, rest, meet, learn. It is a place for recreation, entertainment, reflection, education. At the same time, it is a crossroads, a transit zone.
